RESOLUTION NO. 1652

WHEREAS, the Robert H. Goddard Rocket and Space Wing of the Roswell Museum and Art Center is indigenous to the Roswell area and Chaves County. Through the dedicated effort and contribution of Roswell's own in the areas of research and publicity, the early experiments of Robert H. Goddard himself took place in the shadow of venerable Capitan Mountain setting in motion the age of globe-circling satellites, resounding throughout the civilized world. This is indeed our native heritage.

WHEREAS, the Roswell Rotary Club, collectively and individually, from inception of the movement to activate the Robert H. Goddard Wing and Space Center has contributed massive effort and support in assembling artifacts and enlisting the necessary fiscal life-blood on behalf of the Goddard Workshop.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That the Museum Committee of the Roswell Rotary Club is hereby authorized at their own sole cost and expense to erect and maintain in good repair four (4) each, eight by four foot signs, abutting vehicular highway right-of-way within the corporate limits at the North, South, East and West highway approaches to the City of Roswell, subject to and conditioned upon:

a. Prior clearance and consent in writing, evidencing authority and approval to erect such signs granted by and on behalf of the New Mexico State Highway Department and the New Mexico State Environmental Protection Agency.


b. That the City of Roswell by these presents disclaims any and all right, title and interest in and to any of such signs, as well as any and all costs of erection, maintenance and repair thereof.
