RESOLUTION NO. 1667

WHEREAS, the principal arteries of the City of Roswell have deteriorated in large part due to the passage of heavy trucks; and

WHEREAS, these arteries, being Main Street and Second Street, are also elements of the State Highway System; and

WHEREAS, the deterioration of these streets adversely affects the City of Roswell and the New Mexico Highway system; and

WHEREAS, the transportation needs of Roswell and of southeastern New Mexico urgently require a highway loop system connecting at points exterior to the city, all highways which presently enter the City; and


WHEREAS, in the alternative, a by-pass system which will enable heavy trucks to circumvent the City will reduce the noise and vehicle emission levels within the City, and will serve to retard the deterioration of these streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

The City of Roswell does hereby request the assistance of the New Mexico State Highway Department in analyzing, planning, designing, and constructing a highway loop or truck by-pass system to route large trucks around the City.
