RESOLUTION NO. 1682

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States has heretofore appropriated monies for various public works projects; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Roswell has carefully considered the many needs of this community, and has established priorities in meeting those needs; and

WHEREAS, the following public works project is deemed to be of particular significance to this community:

Storm Sewers; Street Improvements; Water System Remedial Work; Recreational Facilities; Addition to City Hall; Building Repairs at RIAC; Storage at Roswell Museum and Art Center for paintings and other valuables.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

That the above described public works project should be accomplished as soon as possible; and,

The City Council wholeheartedly endorses and supports this project; and

The Mayor is directed to do all things necessary to make application for federal funds for the planning, construction, and implementation of such project, whether such application be prepared by staff members of the City of Roswell, or by other agencies or persons.


