

RESOLUTION NO. 1688

WHEREAS, the Federal Urban Aid System Program requires that participating cities make provision for bike paths, upon citizen request as a part of street improvements unless a street has previously been designated as a non-bike path street; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell does not desire to utilize Union Avenue as a bike path street, either presently or in the future; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to designate Union Avenue as a non-bike path street.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that Union Avenue, extending from Brasher Road to the South and to Nineteenth Street on the North shall not at present or at any future time be designated as a bike path in whole or in part and further that said avenue is hereby designated as a non-bike path street.
