RESOLUTION NO. 1698

WHEREAS, U.S. 70-380 (Second Street) is a Federal Aid Primary Route running through the City of Roswell; and

WHEREAS, the condition of said Second Street has deteriorated through the years necessitating major repairs; and

WHEREAS, the traffic volume has increased to the point where left turn lanes are necessary for the safety and convenience of the driving public; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has attempted and failed at three (3) different special elections to pass bond issues to provide drainage for this project as well as other areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico State Highway Commission has agreed to rebuild and upgrade Second Street when the City has completed the drainage project; and

WHEREAS, having become apparent that the City of Roswell will be unable to provide the proposed drainage project within the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, the need for the re-construction of Second Street exists today to provide for the safety and convenience of the driving public.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico:

1. That the New Mexico State Highway Commission is hereby requested to re-build and repair Second Street in accordance with plans and specifications prepared by the New Mexico State Highway Commission including any drainage structures needed to provide drainage to the project.


2. That the City Council is in agreement with the need for widening Second Street and will support the plans as finally presented by the New Mexico State Highway Commission.
