RESOLUTION NO. 1717

WHEREAS, the governing body, the City Council, of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, deems it necessary and desirable and proposes to have certain renovation work performed on the Cahoon Park swimming pool, such renovation to cost \$40,000, and having Project No. 35-00584; and,

WHEREAS, the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act authorizes grants of Federal funds to States to aid them in providing Outdoor Recreation assistance to State agencies, municipalities, counties, other political subdivisions and public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Natural Resources Department has been designated as the agency to administer the Land and Water Conservation Fund Program for the State of New Mexico, and as such is qualified to receive federal grants under the Land and Water Conservation Act; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of said Act, the Natural Resources Department may apply to the federal government for one-half of the cost of each public Outdoor Recreation project; and

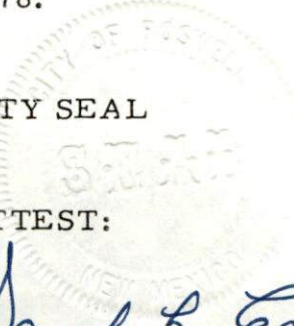
WHEREAS, such funds are necessary to defray the expenses of a proposed project, such funds to be deposited with and administered by the Natural Resources Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body, the City Council, of Roswell, New Mexico, in regular meeting convened, that the New Mexico Natural Resources Department is hereby requested to provide funds for fifty percent (50%) of the actual acquisition, planning and development costs of the above proposed project from funds allocated to the State of New Mexico under the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico Natural Resources Department is hereby assured that the City of Roswell will provide \$20,000. which represents fifty percent (50%) of the acquisition, planning, and development costs of the proposed project.
