RESOLUTION NO. 1724

APPLYING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION FOR REDUCTION IN PER DIEM OF NONSALARIED PUBLIC OFFICERS ATTENDING MEETINGS WITHIN MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS, traditionally, appointed members of all boards, committees and commissions of the City of Roswell have served without compensation as part of their public service and duty;

WHEREAS, the 1978 New Mexico Legislature has amended the "Per Diem and Mileage Act" (N.M. Stat. Ann. §§ 5-10-1 through 5-10-3.1) to provide for the payment of per diem of \$32. per meeting for all meetings attended with the municipal boundaries by nonsalaried public officers;

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Roswell has determined that the payment of per diem under Section 5-10-3 A(1) would require payment of significant sums of money from the annual revenues of the City of Roswell;

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Finance and Administration of the State of New Mexico may reduce the rates set for per diem and mileage for any class of public officials and employees or for any local government pursuant to N.M. Stat. Ann. § 5-10-3.1C.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City of Roswell apply to the Secretary of Finance and Administration of the State of New Mexico to reduce the amount of payment of per diem for nonsalaried public officers from \$32 to \$Zero (0) per meeting attended within the municipal boundaries of the City of Roswell; and

RESOLVED, that this application be submitted to the Secretary of Finance and Administration for approval.




