

RESOLUTION NO. 1798

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN AMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING IMMEDIATE ACTION AND PURCHASES UNDER AUTHORITY OF SECTION 13-1-15 N.M.S.A. (1978).

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell operates a municipal water utility and is required to maintain the supply of water to the customers of said utility, and

WHEREAS, the motor on the pump for Well No. 17 has failed and its repair is the responsibility of the City of Roswell, and

WHEREAS, such repair must be made immediately, in order to assure adequate water supply for the municipal water system, and

WHEREAS, the Public Purchases Act, at Section 13-1-15 authorizes emergency purchases by order without bids in an unforeseen situation requiring immediate action to preserve property within the jurisdiction of the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND DECLARED by the governing body, the City Council, of Roswell, New Mexico, that an emergency situation necessitating immediate action exists in the instance of the failure of the motor on Well No. 17 and that maintaining an adequate water supply requires purchase of parts and labor by order, without bids and further, that the City staff is authorized to proceed with such repairs in conformity with this resolution and the Public Purchases Act.


