

RESOLUTION NO. 1800

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE NEW MEXICO REGIONAL
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Health and Environmental Department and its Emergency Medical Services Bureau, in cooperation with the Emergency Medical Services Region III Council is making application for federal funds to implement a Regional Medical Services System, and

WHEREAS, this Regional Emergency Medical Services System will provide for improved emergency medical care for acutely ill and injured by developing closer coordination and communication among existing medical facilities that will serve the needs of this community, and

WHEREAS, we recognize the importance of ongoing support for emergency medical services, and

WHEREAS, the quality of emergency medical services will be improved by the development and implementation of an Emergency Medical Services System,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body, the City Council, of Roswell, New Mexico, that we endorse this effort to develop and implement an Emergency Medical Services System in EMS Region III that will insure the rapid stabilization, transportation and treatment of critically injured and ill patients and regard the ongoing provision of emergency medical services as a top priority.
