

RESOLUTION NO. 1821

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING IMMEDIATE ACTION AND PURCHASES UNDER AUTHORITY OF SECTION 13-1-15 N.M.S.A. (1978) FOR REPAIR OF A BOOSTER PUMP MOTOR.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell operates a municipal water utility and has obligated itself to supply water to its customers, and

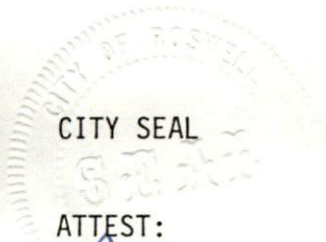
WHEREAS, a pump motor for a booster pump in the water distribution system, at the Kerr Booster Station, has failed and its repair is the responsibility of the City of Roswell, and

WHEREAS, such repair must be made immediately, in order to assure adequate water availability and public safety in the city, and


WHEREAS, the Public Purchases Act, at Section 13-1-15 authorizes emergency purchases by order without bids in an unforeseen situation requiring immediate action to preserve property within the jurisdiction of the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND DECLARED by the governing body, the City Council, of Roswell, New Mexico, that an emergency situation necessitating immediate action exists in the booster pump motor failure and requires purchase of parts and labor by order, without bids and further, that the City staff is authorized to proceed with such repairs in conformity with this resolution and the Public Purchases Act.
