

RESOLUTION NO. 1822

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING IMMEDIATE ACTION AND PURCHASES UNDER AUTHORITY OF SECTION 13-1-15 N.M.S.A. (1978) FOR REPAIR OF SNORKLE NO. 1.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell provides fire protection for the protection of its citizens and their property, and

WHEREAS, the engine in Snorkle No. 1 of the Roswell Fire Department has suffered damage and its repair is the responsibility of the City of Roswell, and

WHEREAS, such repair must be made immediately, since Snorkle No. 1 is the only piece of aerial apparatus in the City, and

WHEREAS, the Public Purchases Act, at Section 13-1-15 authorizes emergency purchases by order without bids in an unforeseen situation requiring immediate action to preserve property within the jurisdiction of the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND DECLARED by the governing body, the City Council, of Roswell, New Mexico, that an emergency situation necessitating immediate action exists in the engine damage on Snorkle No. 1 of the Roswell Fire Department and that public safety requires purchase of parts and labor by order, without bids and further, that the City staff is authorized to proceed with such repairs in conformity with this resolution and the Public Purchases Act.


