

RESOLUTION NO. 1826

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF COMMUNITY ACCESS
CABLE TELEVISION

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell views Community Access Broadcasting as a major telecommunication link for present and future cable subscribers into areas of public, education, municipal government and civic group access broadcasting, and

WHEREAS, this Community Access will provide programming produced for, by and about this All America City, and

WHEREAS, a broad based Community Access Advisory Commission will be appointed by the City of Roswell to establish funding, staff and site requirements, and develop purposes, guidelines and objectives for Community Access Broadcasting and a Cable Television Access Center, and

WHEREAS, at a time when concern exists for communication within our community, quality education for all its citizens and a desire to provide the highest level of services for the taxpayer,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Roswell in its desire to better address the aforementioned concerns and make this community a better place to live, adopts this resolution for the establishment of Community Access Cable Television for the community to be provided on channels carried over the present Cablecom of Roswell network and hereby further informs Capital City Communications of Englewood, Colorado, the parent company of Cablecom of Roswell, of this resolution and encourages their close involvement through access channel(s) designation and a commitment toward equipment and operating costs.
