

RESOLUTION NO. 1833

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL
IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL NUMBER 128.

WHEREAS, rapid development of natural gas and other petroleum resources in Chaves County has recently caused a great increase in vehicular traffic on the streets of Roswell, New Mexico, and

WHEREAS, the present traffic increase does now and will continue to imperil the safety of Roswell's residents, and

WHEREAS, projected growth in the already heavy traffic foretells even greater dangers for the area citizens, and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 128 would provide for construction of a truck bypass on U.S. Highway 285 that would materially reduce truck traffic through Roswell and thereby the hazards associated with the increased traffic levels, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Roswell desires to express its concern about the present dangers and support for the truck bypass proposed in Senate Bill No. 128 and its desire that others join in support of the essential improvements provided in that bill,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that on behalf of the City Council and the citizens of Roswell the support of the City of Roswell for Senate Bill No. 128 is hereby announced and all legislators and citizens of the state are urgently requested to join with the city in supporting and enacting the legislation contained therein.
