

RESOLUTION NO. 1841

WHEREAS, at the bond election held in connection with the regular municipal election duly called within the City of Roswell (the "City"), on Tuesday, March 2, 1982, there was approved by a majority of the total votes cast thereon a general obligation Fire Protection Facilities Bond Question, which question was authorized to be submitted by a resolution duly adopted on January 12, 1982, by the City Council of the City (the "Council"), which question is herein incorporated by reference in full; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk has so certified to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY (THE CITY COUNCIL) OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. The above certificate of the Clerk is hereby accepted and the same is hereby spread upon the minutes of the Council.


Section 2. It is hereby declared and determined that the election of March 2, 1982 resulted in favor of the issuance of the general obligation Fire Protection Facilities Bonds.
