

RESOLUTION NO. 1842

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL IN
SUPPORT OF A U.S. 285 TRUCK BYPASS.

WHEREAS, rapid development of natural gas and other petroleum resources in Chaves County has greatly increased the heavy truck traffic on the streets of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, and

WHEREAS, U.S. 285 (Main Street) is the only available, feasible route for this heavy truck traffic to use, and


WHEREAS, projected growth of the already heavy truck traffic foretells of substantial dangers for area citizens, and

WHEREAS, the East Side U.S. 285 truck bypass would materially reduce the heavy truck traffic on U.S. 285 (Main Street) and reduce the potential danger associated with this increase in truck traffic, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Roswell desires to express its concern about the present and future dangers of heavy truck traffic on U.S. 285 (Main Street),

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that on behalf of the City Council and the citizens of Roswell the support of the East Side U.S. 285 Truck Bypass as the number one priority highway need in Chaves County is hereby announced and the New Mexico State Highway Commission is urged to declare that an emergency situation exists within Chaves County and add this critically needed road to the New Mexico State Highway System and include this road in their current five (5) year plan.
