

RESOLUTION NO. 1906

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, LIMITING APPEARANCES BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL AND CITY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS BY THE MEMBERS OF SAID BODIES.

WHEREAS, many local professionals and business people now serve and will in the future serve the City as members of the City Council and as members of various boards and commissions, and


WHEREAS, state law prohibits participation by public officers, whether elected, appointed, or hired in official acts wherein they have a financial interest, and

WHEREAS, a member appearing before a body as a representative for another party may give rise to the appearance of impropriety under the state law,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that it shall be the policy of the City Council and each of the City's boards and commissions that no person shall appear before a body of which they are a member as a representative of any party. Further, that the presiding officers of such bodies shall not excuse members from the body for the purpose of appearing before it as a representative of any party.
