

RESOLUTION NO. 1935

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW MEXICO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT DIVISION FOR \$3,600,000.00 OF STATE FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF ROSWELL WASTEWATER FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Legislature has enacted Chapter 10, Laws of 1984 (Special Session) appropriating twenty million, one hundred thousand dollars (\$20,100,000.00) to the E.I.D. for expenditure from the proceeds of the sale of Severance Tax Bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act for the building of wastewater treatment plant facilities in Albuquerque, Las Cruces and Roswell; and

WHEREAS, the E.I.D. has determined that three million, six hundred thousand dollars (\$3,600,000.00) of that amount shall be made available for wastewater facilities in Roswell,

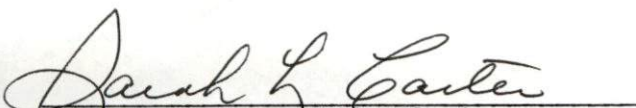
