FOR REPAIRS TO WELL NO. 13


WHEREAS, Well No. 13 in the City's water system unexpectedly broke down during May, 1984, and


WHEREAS, said well is an integral part of the municipal water system for the City and necessary to assure sufficient water for fire protection and preservation of the public health, and

WHEREAS, New Mexico State law, Section 13-1-15, N.M.S.A. (1978), allows for certain emergency purchases when an unforeseen occurrence endangers public safety and health,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO that the unforeseen breakdown of Well No. 13 constitutes an immediate threat to public safety and health and that necessary repairs are authorized pursuant to Section 13-1-15, N.M.S.A (1978).
