

RESOLUTION NO. 1949

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL,  
AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY PURCHASE OF A  
FIRE TRUCK FOR USE BY THE CITY FIRE  
DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, occupancy of new buildings within the City has resulted in a significant increase in the areas not accessible with the City's existing fire equipment, and


WHEREAS, the ability to provide adequate fire service to these occupied structures is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City and materially affects fire insurance ratings in the City, and

WHEREAS, the City has located a suitable reconditioned fire truck considerably less expensive than a new truck but which must be purchased immediately or lost,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY OCUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that there exists an emergency situation that requires immediate action to preserve the health and safety of the citizens of Roswell and their property in that the subject fire truck, a 1972 Seagrave ladder truck, is immediately needed. Its equivalent could not be purchased within the City budget except in this instance. Further, the City staff and the Mayor and City Clerk are directed and authorized to effect the purchase of the truck from World Wide Fire Apparatus for an approximate price of \$100,000.
