

RESOLUTION NO. 1994

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL ACCEPTING A VACATION PLAT IN THE J. H. GREGG TRACT AND AUTHORIZING ITS RECORDING.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has heretofore approved vacation of rights-of-way in the J. H. Gregg Tract by Resolution No. 723, July 7, 1950, and


WHEREAS, the earlier resolution was not recorded and would cause certain inconveniences if now recorded, and

WHEREAS, a new plat showing a portion of the earlier vacation, relating to a portion of Gregg Drive and appurtenant alleys, has been prepared by Richard B. Wright, RPLS, and dated January 24, 1986.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that the plat relating to vacation of portions of the J. H. Gregg Tract, earlier vacated by Resolution No. 723, is hereby approved and its recording is hereby authorized excepting only that such utility lines as are presently within the vacated right-of-way shall be allowed to continue in place with reasonable access thereto.
