

RESOLUTION NO. 2044

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN MAINSTREET NEW MEXICO AND DESIGNATING A CITY OFFICIAL TO REPRESENT THE CITY ON THE LOCAL MAINSTREET NON-PROFIT GOVERNING BOARD.

WHEREAS, the MainStreet New Mexico Project has been created to assist communities to develop a public-private effort to revitalize their downtown "Main Street" areas, and


WHEREAS, three New Mexico cities may be selected by MainStreet New Mexico, Office of the Lt. Governor, to participate in the project in 1988,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL that the City:


1. Endorses the submission of this application and agrees to participate in the development and the financial support of the local MainStreet program.
2. Endorses the goal of economic revitalization of the central business district within the context of the preservation and rehabilitation of its historic buildings.
3. Will appoint a city official to represent the City on the local "Main Street" governing board.
4. Will fund and employ a full-time Main Street Manager for three years and provide the manager with funds for travel to training meetings.
