**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL APPROVING AND DIRECTING THE PURCHASE OF RECYCLED PRODUCTS, ESPECIALLY POST CONSUMER PAPER, RE-REFINED OIL AND RETREAD TIRES AS POSSIBLE BY THE CITY.**

**WHEREAS**, conservation of natural resources and nonrenewable energy resources is essential to the future of this community and to the future of the earth, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roswell can act now to both reduce the consumption of natural resources and energy and to model for others the resolve necessary to improve the lives of Roswell's citizens, and

**WHEREAS**, April 22, 1995 is the twenty-fifth anniversary of Earth Day, an important occasion that reminds everyone we are all in this together and only by working together can we do the things we must do to preserve the earth for those who will follow us;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO**, that the City of Roswell shall be a leader in recycling and that the City's purchase of recycled products, especially post consumer paper, re-refined oil, and retread tires, is hereby approved and directed in all instances where such products are found to meet the City's requirements.
