

RESOLUTION NO. 2286

A RESOLUTION
SUPPORTING THE NAMING OF HIGHWAY 64 BETWEEN TAOS AND
TIERRA AMARILLA "JACK M. CAMPBELL HIGHWAY"

WHEREAS, Jack M. Campbell served as Governor of the State of New Mexico from 1963 to 1966, having resided in Roswell prior to that time, and

WHEREAS, former Governor Campbell has recently marked his 79th birthday, and

WHEREAS, during Governor Campbell's administration, the present Capitol Building, State Library and the Rio Grande Gorge Bridge on U. S. Highway 64 between Taos and Tierra Amarilla were constructed, and

WHEREAS, the \$3 million bridge was a construction feat and because it was built almost entirely without federal money, it also was a remarkable political accomplishment of former Governor Jack M. Campbell, and

WHEREAS, in 1965, the Highway Commission designated the Taos to Tierra Amarilla segment of Highway 64 as "Jack M. Campbell Highway", but no signs are currently marking the route;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico, hereby supports renewing the Highway Commission's 1965 resolution as part of the celebration of the 30th anniversary of the dedication of the Rio Grande Gorge Bridge and placing adequate signage marking the route.
