

RESOLUTION NO. 2314

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO
APPROVING AND SUPPORTING A JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT WITH
THE NEW MEXICO STATE HIGHWAY & TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO
RENOVATE THE SOUTH WEST CORNER OF FIFTH STREET AND MAIN STREET,
THE FORMER CONOCO GAS FILLING STATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to participate in the renovation of the former Conoco gas filling station along with the Hispano Chamber of Commerce, and

WHEREAS, the City assumes ownership, liability, and maintenance for the renovated facility and related amenities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has the required funding for the project as agreed to in the Joint Powers Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY,
THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO that:

- 1) The City of Roswell fully supports and endorses the proposed project to renovate the Conoco gas filling station.
- 2) The Mayor of the City of Roswell is authorized to enter into the Joint Powers Agreement with the New Mexico State Highway & Transportation Department.
- 3) The funding for the project is available.
