

RESOLUTION NO. 2385

A CONCEPT RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO FOR THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO STATE HIGHWAY & TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDING FOR THE MAIN STREET (US70- 285) MEDIAN BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT. THIS FUNDING WILL BE USED FOR RECONSTRUCTING THE MEDIANS FROM McGAFFEY STREET TO COLLEGE BOULEVARD IN ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO.

WHEREAS, this project is an eligible activity under the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) of 1991; and

WHEREAS, the Main Street Median Beautification Project is an approved Capital Improvement Project as noted in the "City of Roswell Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan, 1992"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell agrees to provide matching funds at a percentage rate of 25% of the cost of land acquisition and construction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell agrees to fund all Project Development and Design costs separate from the cost of land acquisition and construction; and

WHEREAS, City of Roswell has agreed to fund all on-going maintenance costs for this enhancement project beyond construction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell supports this project and desires to receive funding; and


WHEREAS, The City of Roswell understands two resolutions must be submitted, one at the time of an enhancement project application and another at the time the project is formally under contract with the New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is an application for Transportation Enhancement funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that the Mayor, or his representative be, and hereby is, authorized to submit an application for Transportation Enhancement funding to the New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department for the Main Street (US 70-285) Beautification Project in Roswell, New Mexico and hereby commits to the concept of such project as specified in the enhancement project application.
