

RESOLUTION 2389

WHEREAS, at the special mail-ballot bond election duly called and held within the City of Roswell, on Tuesday, November 12, 1997, 10 separate general obligation bond questions were submitted to the qualified voters of the City, which questions were authorized to be submitted by Resolution No. 2378, duly adopted on September 11, 1997, by the City Council of the City of Roswell; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk and Robert B. Corn, Magistrate Judge for Chaves County have certified the results of the election on each question in the Certificate of Canvass presented to the Council on the date hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO THAT:

Section 1. The above Certificate of Canvass is accepted and the same is hereby spread upon the minutes of the governing body.

Section 2. It is hereby declared and determined that the election of November 12, 1997, resulted as follows:

(1) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation South Park cemetery bonds in the amount of \$900,000 as submitted at such election "failed to carry" by a majority of the total votes cast,

(2) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation A.D.A. public buildings bonds in the amount of \$500,000 as submitted at such election "failed to carry" by a majority of the total votes cast,

(3) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation street bonds in the amount of \$2,000,000 "failed to carry" by a majority of the votes cast,

(4) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation public library bonds in the amount of \$3,207,000 "failed to carry" by a majority of the total votes cast,

(5) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation city garage improvement bonds in the amount of \$850,000 "failed to carry" by a majority of the total votes cast,

(6) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation public parks bonds in the amount of \$1,900,000 "failed to carry" by a majority of the total votes cast,

(7) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation family aquatic center bonds in the amount of \$3,982,000 "failed to carry" by a majority of the total votes cast,

(8) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation museum improvement bonds in the amount of not exceeding \$200,000 "failed to carry" by a majority of the total votes cast,

(9) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation fire stations bonds in the amount of not exceeding \$2,450,000 "failed to carry" by a majority of the total votes cast, and

(10) the proposition to issue the City's general obligation police station bonds in the aggregate principal amount of not exceeding \$150,000 "failed to carry" by a majority of the total votes cast.

Section 3. All action heretofore taken by the governing body and officers of the City, not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, directed toward the calling and conducting of said election be, and the same is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.
