

RESOLUTION NO. 2397

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SOUTHEASTERN NEW MEXICO
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT
AND
REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO STATE LEGISLATURE
TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS
AT THE CURRENT LEVEL**

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell appreciates and benefits from the services provided by the Southeastern New Mexico Economic Development District (Planning District #6) which is one of seven Councils of Government (COGs) in New Mexico, and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Finance Committee (LFC) has recommended a reduction in the 1998 LFC Budget from \$275,000.00 to \$200,000.00 which will negatively impact the operations of the COGs, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell will be negatively impacted by any reduction of services by the Southeastern New Mexico Economic Development District and wishes to maintain the existing quality service, and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico State Legislature is in session to consider the State Budget for next year,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the governing body, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico:

That all of Roswell's legislators and the entire New Mexico Legislature be encouraged and requested to provide funding at the current level of \$275,000.00 for the New Mexico Council of Governments which will continue to provide quality service to District #6.
