

**RESOLUTION NO. 2420**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION OF A PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGE AT ROSWELL INDUSTRIAL AIR CENTER.**


WHEREAS, the City of Roswell operates, maintains and develops the Airport with federal grants, user fees and other local funds; and

WHEREAS, a Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) is a user fee authorized by Federal Law and imposed only on eligible enplaned passengers utilizing the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Committee after thorough investigation and having held a public meeting on the feasibility issue has recommended to the City Council that the funds generated by adopting and collecting a PFC are needed to accomplish projects designed to enhance capacity, safety and development of the Roswell Industrial Air Center;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico that the City Manager is authorized to file an application with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), authorizing the imposition of a PFC at the Airport, and the expenditure of revenues from the PFC at the Roswell Industrial Air Center, in accordance with the Capital Improvement Program, and the assurances and understandings contained in the application.
