RESOLUTION NO. 2463**

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY CLERK TO PETITION THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY COMMISSION FOR ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY INTO THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell wishes to reach a population of over fifty-thousand residents, and

WHEREAS, the proposed annexation areas are contiguous to the City boundaries and the proposed areas are of the development and usage in keeping with the City of Roswell's master plan, and

WHEREAS, the City can, in a reasonable amount of time, provide services to the areas proposed for annexation in a planned series of phases,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Governing Body that the Mayor and the City Clerk be authorized and directed to petition the Municipal Boundary Commission of the State of New Mexico for the annexation of the following areas contiguous to the current boundaries of the City (as described on the map which is hereto attached as Exhibit), and that this petition be submitted with the support and highest priority of the City of Roswell:
