

RESOLUTION No. 2479

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL SUPPORTING A BROAD BASED STRATEGY TO COMBAT DRUG ABUSE.

WHEREAS, the City government and citizens of Roswell have long recognized the destructive effects of illegal drugs on the families and residents of the City; and,

WHEREAS those effects include spouse and child abuse, burglary and theft, addiction, death and even murder; and,

WHEREAS this Governing Body and the community have always supported the efforts of the Roswell Police Department in eliminating the trafficking and abuse of illegal drugs: either through such approaches as the Metro Narcotics task force or the DARE and GREAT programs; and,


WHEREAS the City has promoted a broad based approach to the elimination of illegal drug use consisting of law enforcement, treatment and education to combat the problem within our community; and,

WHEREAS this broad based policy is also the national drug policy; and,

WHEREAS this policy may not supply all the answers to the problems posed by illegal drug use in our community, it is the best policy for this people at this time.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL that we support the present broad based policy and the elimination of the devastating effects of illegal drug abuse and the policy most supportive of our law enforcement officers.
